One copy of the Proposed Permit Determination (0990350-012-AV) for the renewal of the Title V Air Operation Permit (0990350-010-AV) for the South Florida Water Management District Pump Station S-6 located at the Hillsborough Canal where the northern corner of Water Conservation Area 2-A meets with the western edge of Water Conservation Area 1 (L-6, L-7, L-15, and L-39), near the city of Belle Glade. The UTM coordinates are Zone 17; 555.27 km E; 2928.156 km N; Latitude: 26° 28' 21" N/ Longitude: 80° 26' 44" W., Palm Beach County, is enclosed. This letter is only a courtesy to inform you that the draft permit has become a PROPOSED permit.

Pursuant to Section 403.0872(6), Florida Statutes, if no objection to the proposed Title V air operation permit is made by the USEPA within 45 days, the proposed permit will become a final permit no later than 55 days after the date on which the proposed permit was mailed (posted) to USEPA. If USEPA has an objection to the proposed permit, the final permit will not be issued until the permitting authority receives written notice that the objection is resolved or withdrawn.
