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This initial Title V Operation Permit is for the purpose of incorporating the terms and conditions of Air Construction Permit 0990615-001-AC, issued on January 29, 2004. SFWMD Pump Station G-372 is located 15 miles west of U.S. 27 on L-5 Canal, then 7 miles north along the Miami River Canal (East Side), NW corner of Holey Land Wildlife Management, Palm Beach County, Florida. UTM Coordinates: UTM: Zone 17; 519.335 km E; 2923.608 km N Latitude 26° 26' 04" North and Longitude: 80° 48' 22" West. Pump Station G-372 consists of four (4) 1,530 horsepower (hp) Fairbanks-Morse diesel engine/pump combinations, and two (2) 1,135 hp emergency generators. The engines at this station are used to power four flood control pumps.

STATEMENT OF BASIS: The Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) has permitting jurisdiction under Chapter 403.087, F.S. However, in accordance with Section 403.182, F.S., the FDEP recognizes the Health Department as the approved local air pollution control program in Palm Beach County. As such, the FDEP and the Health Department have entered into a Specific Operating Agreement that delegates to the Health Department the authority to issue or deny permits for this type of air pollution source located in Palm Beach County.

This Title V air operation permit is issued under the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) Chapters 62-4, 62-210, and 62-213. The above named permittee is hereby authorized to perform the work or operate the facility shown on the application and approved drawings, plans, and other documents, attached hereto or on file with the permitting authority, in accordance with the terms and conditions of this permit.


