Pursuant to Section 403.0872(6), Florida Statutes, if no objection to the PROPOSED permit renewal is made by the U.S.EPA within 45 days, the PROPOSED permit renewal will become a FINAL permit renewal no later than 55 days after the date on which the PROPOSED permit renewal was mailed (posted) to U.S.EPA. If U.S.EPA has an objection to the PROPOSED permit renewal, the FINAL permit renewal will not be issued until the permitting authority receives written notice that the objection is resolved or withdrawn.
