Enclosed is Permit Number 0330067-002-AC, issued pursuant to Section 403.087, Florida Statutes.

Your September 13 letter requested a number of changes to the permit, and we have incorporated as many as we believe possible. These are numbered consistent with your letter, and include:

1. We changed the language in Section 1.A to read "wet scrubbers providing odor control", consistent with Section 1.B. We inserted the language "make-up" before combustion air in referring to the gas sent through the scrubber/condenser both in this section and in Section III.A. We changed the description in the Table of Contents to reflect "odor control scrubbers". We noted that each odor control scrubber has an air flow capacity of 27,500 scfm.
4. We changed "Utility" to "Utilities".
5. The requirement to notify of design heat input is contained in 40CFR60.48c(a)1; and it is inappropriate to change this federally mandated reporting requirement.
6. As above, we noted that each odor control scrubber has an air flow capacity of 27,500 scfm.
7. We believe that the inclusion of a maximum allowable operating rate is appropriate. Since these scrubbers have no source specific emission limits we concurred with your request to delete conditions B.3 and B.4. We believe the recordkeeping in condition B.5 (now, B.3) is appropriate. We concurred with your request to move condition B.6 to Section II.


We hope these changes address your concerns.

Any party to this Order (permit) has the right to seek judicial review of the permit pursuant to Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, by the filing of a Notice of Appeal pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the Clerk of the Department in the Office of General Counsel, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000, and by filing a copy of the Notice of

Appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within 30 days from the date this Notice is filed with the Clerk of the Department.
