I. Comment(s).

No comments were received from the USEPA during their 45 day review period of the PROPOSED Permit.

Minor comments were received from Mr. Tom Davis, P.E. on behalf of the applicant on December 20, 2013.

The following permit sections are revised as indicated. **Strikethrough** is used to denote the deletion of text. **Double-underlines** are used to denote the addition of text. All changes are emphasized with **yellow highlight**.

1. Page 4 of 6 of the Draft/Proposed Title V Air Operation Permit No. 0310179-022-AV. In addition to NSPS Subpart Kb, EU-033 is subject to 40 CFR 60 Subpart A, 40 CFR 63 Subpart A, and 40 CFR 63 Subpart BBBB.

Response: Based on the comment, the Regulation table on Page 4 is revised as follows:
