We have reviewed your request for an extension of the above permit, received on May 8<sup>th</sup>, 2014. Pursuant to that request, the expiration date of the permit is changed as follows:

**This letter must be attached to the original permit and becomes part of that permit. The remaining provisions of the permit are not changed by this action and remain in effect.**

*The Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has permitting jurisdiction under Section 403.087, Florida Statutes (F.S.). However, in accordance with Section 403.182, F.S., the DEP recognizes the Florida Department of Health Palm Beach County (Health Department) as the approved local air pollution control program of Palm Beach County. Through a Specific Operating Agreement, the DEP authorized the Health Department to issue or deny permits for this type of air pollution source located in Palm Beach County.*

**Administrative Hearing:** A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Florida Department of Health Palm Beach County Legal Office, located at 800 Clematis Street in West Palm Beach, Florida, 33401 (Telephone: (561) 671-4000, Fax (561) 837-5195). Petitions filed by the permit applicant or any of the parties listed below must be filed within fourteen days of receipt of this permit extension. A petitioner must mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above, at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination

(hearing) under sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205, F.A.C.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the permitting authority's action is based must contain the following information:

- (a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, if known;
- (b) The name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner; the name, address and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how the petitioner's substantial interests will be affected by the agency determination;
- (c) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the agency action or proposed action;
- (d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so indicate;
- (e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, as well as the rules and statutes which entitle the petitioner to relief;
- (f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; and,
- (g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action.

A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the permitting authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Department's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this modification. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Department on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.


**Effective:** The permit extension is final and effective on the date filed with the Clerk of the Health Department *unless* a petition is filed in accordance with the above paragraphs *or unless* a request for an extension of time in which to file a petition is filed within 14 days of receipt of this permitting action and conforms to Rule 62-103.070, F.A.C. Upon timely filing of a petition or a request for an extension of time, this permit will not be effective until further Order of the Health Department.

Any party to this Final Order has the right to seek judicial review pursuant to Section 120.68, F.S., by the filing of a Notice of Appeal pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure with the Health Department at the address listed below; and by filing a copy of the Notice of Appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within 30 days from the date this Order is filed with the Clerk of the Health Department.

Mediation is not available for this action.

Dear Mr. Tallam:

This letter is to request the extension of Air Construction Permit No. 0990702-001-AC for the Sonavation, Inc. (Sonavation) Palm Beach Gardens facility. The Palm Beach Gardens facility obtained a construction permit for the new biometric products manufacturing facility that includes the operation of a baghouse. Sonavation is requesting to extend the construction permit expiration for approximately six (6) months to enable the performance testing (in accordance with Condition 3.3.1) to be completed and results to be included in the initial air operating permit application.

Due to unforeseen installation delays for the new facility operations, the new process and baghouse did not commence operation until April 2014. Condition 2.1.8 requires that an air operation permit is required for regular operation of the permitted emission unit, and Sonavation is required to apply for and receive an air operation permit prior to the expiration of the construction permit (0990702-001-AC). Sonavation is currently scheduling the aforementioned initial compliance testing (lead emissions) with the selected testing firm. The testing notification will be provided to Palm Beach County, Division of Environmental Public Health, Air and Waste Program (Palm Beach County) at least 15 days prior to the scheduled test date. The compliance testing results will be provided to Palm Beach County within 45 days of the completed testing date.

The current construction permit expires June 26, 2014, and Sonavation requests a one year extension to June 26, 2015 in accordance with Condition 2.1.9. The requested extension for the construction permit expiration date will enable sufficient time for the compliance testing, operation permit application, and final operation permit issuance by Palm Beach County.

Per 62-4.505(4)(s)3, F.A.C., a fee of \$50 for the time extension of the construction permit expiration is enclosed for a minor modification of a permit that does not require substantial technical evaluation by Palm Beach County and will not lead to substantially different environmental impacts or will lessen the impacts of the initial construction permit.
