Since the general air permit is not transferable to the new owner, a new general permit application will need to be submitted to DEP Headquarters in Tallahassee. A air general permit application for cast polymer operations was given to the new owner to complete and send to Tallahassee to register the facility. A master resin and gelcoat spreadsheet was also e-mailed to the new owner for recording and submittal of the facilities resin and gelcoat usage for the past twelve(12) consecutive months. A new permit has been received and processed in DEP's main office in Tallahassee. Totals for resin and gelcoat usage were faxed on 8/20/08 to the Dept's South District office in Ft. Myers with the total for the last consecutive 12 months usage equaling 31, 474 lbs.
