Emissions from the 650 bbl silo are controlled by a Standley Batch Systems, Inc. dust collector. The dust collector contains sixteen (16) polyester spring mounted dust bags. While the cement is pnuematically transferred from the truck to the silo, an enclosed timer control, also manufactured by Standley Batch Systems, Inc., controls the vibrator cleaning system cleaning the bags at intervals during the process.


