
The facility operates with one central batch plant encompassing two (z) rotary mixers, three (3) cement silos, two (z) multi-compartment aggregate bins and an aggregate storage area to produce both dry and wet concrete for its precast operations.

Each of the three (3) silos has a hag house. The bag houses are routinely maintained to insure their integrity.

Independent (non-employee) cement houlers/pump-off drivers are noutinely reminded to unload into the silos at 10 PSI.

A visual emissions test is performed annually by a qualified and licensed vendor. Results are filed with the State (local office). The last VE was performed on all 3 silos on 11/28 - all 3 received a passing grade.
