

A-1 Block Corporation recently purchased this existing Ready-Mix plant in Zellwood. The plant has three product storage silos and a batching operation.

The southern most silo has a capacity of 125 tons and contains cement. Emissions from the silo loading are controlled by two WAM Silo Top Dust Collectors, Model FC3J 07-200

The middle silo is empty at this time and has a capacity of 30 tons. Emissions will be controlled by a WAM Silo Top Dust Collector, Model FC3J 07-200

The northern most silo has a capacity of 50 tons and contains fly ash. The emissions are controlled by a WAM Silo Top Dust Collector, Model FC3J 07-200

Due to the old age of this equipment, the serial numbers are unknown for each of the dust collectors. A copy of the equipment specifications for the dust collectors are included with this application.

There is batching at this plant but no control equipment is associated with the batching, water is used to control emissions from this process.
