In looking through the ARMS database, I noticed that the entitlement for the following facilities has expired. The last time we heard from each (when they paid their annual emissions fee) is also identified below. The last year invoiced for the annual emissions fee is 2002 (invoices for 2003 will go out in December of 2003)

I suspect some of these facilities are no longer in operation. However, if they are still operating of course they will need to submit another notification form. She noted that the perchloroethylene and spotting chemicals have been removed from the facility. She also stated that the eligibility will be maintained under the Title V general permit for possible future perchloroethylene dry cleaning. Ms. Perez was asked to supply the original purchase date for the dry-to-dry machine. Ms. Perez telephoned on 02/05/2003 with original purchase date of 12/28/1991 for dry-to-dry machine.
